To be eligible, youth need

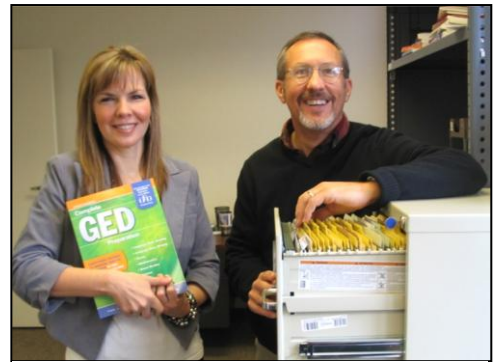
to be 16-21 years of age,  
not be attending high school,  
meet income guidelines,

and have **one** of these factors:

- Need to get a GED
- Pregnant or be a young parent
- On probation/parole or have been in court
- Deficient in math/reading or had a school IEP
- Require assistance to secure or hold a job

- GED assessment and tutoring
- Assistance finding employment
- Subsidized employment opportunities
- Resume creation
- Assistance completing the FAFSA application
- Help finding grants and loans for education
- Coaching on how to apply and interview for jobs, career counseling, budgeting instruction, and much more.
