Illinois Sheriffs' Association ANNOUNCES SCHOLARSHIPS

The Illinois Sheriffs' Association announces that it will be awarding over \$53,500 in college scholarships throughout the State of Illinois to students wishing to pursue higher education during the 2018-2019 academic years. The scholarships are to be applied to tuition, books, and fees only. The student must be enrolled full-time at a certified institution of higher learning within the State of Illinois.

Sheriff Dwight A. Baird, Kendall County, will be awarding one scholarship in the amount of \$500.

There will be no restriction on any applicant by reason of race, age, creed, color, sex, or national origin. The only limitations are as follows:

- Applicants must be permanent Illinois residents
- > Scholarships must be utilized at institutions of higher learning within the State of Illinois
- > Students must be enrolled as a full-time student during the 2018-2019 school years. (excluding summer session)

Applications are now available at the Kendall County Sheriff's Office, 1102 Cornell Lane, Yorkville, Illinois 60560, on the Kendall County website @ www.co.kendall.il.us/sheriff or on the **ISA website www.ilsheriff.org**. Students must complete the application; answer the essay question and return all documentation to the **Sheriff's Office** in their permanent county of residence by **March 15**, 2018 (must be postmarked by this date).
