Participants will also be expected to have a high degree of inter-rater reliability when they determine a final rating based on the evidence gathered during the **Skill Building AA#1801** accuracy and consistency in ratings (Domains 2 & 3), calibrate evidence vs interpretation to control for bias and standardize Gathering March **Evidence During Observations &** 12 Conferencing educators and calibrate accuracy of evidence collections, alignment, and Using the ratings to insure consistency and inter-rater reliability. **Danielson Model** This course focuses on Domains 1 & 4 and is intended for those administrators who have successfully completed Initial Teacher Evaluation required by ISBE. Participants will record data from a pre-conference, align data to the Danielson Framework (Domain 1), collaboratively determine Competency ratings, observe post-conferences, evaluate teacher evidence, and align to the Danielson Framework (Domain 4). Participants will learn how to use assessments & measurement AA#3000 March models, use data from the evaluation rubric and other **Principal/Teacher** evidence collected, create supportive, targeted professional 20 **Evaluator** development plans, and communicate evaluation outcomes **Retraining:** and findings in constructive and supportive ways that enable Student Growth Participants will learn how to utilize current evaluation data for all licensed staff to create individual, targeted small group, and school-wide PD plans. Participants use Professional Learning Plan (PLP) tools to develop detailed plans aligned with school improvement goals to address defined needs.
